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WESTSIDE JAM 2010 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

THE COURSE:

The course will comprise of 4 obstacles and a section for wake tricks with 2 turning bouys at each end.

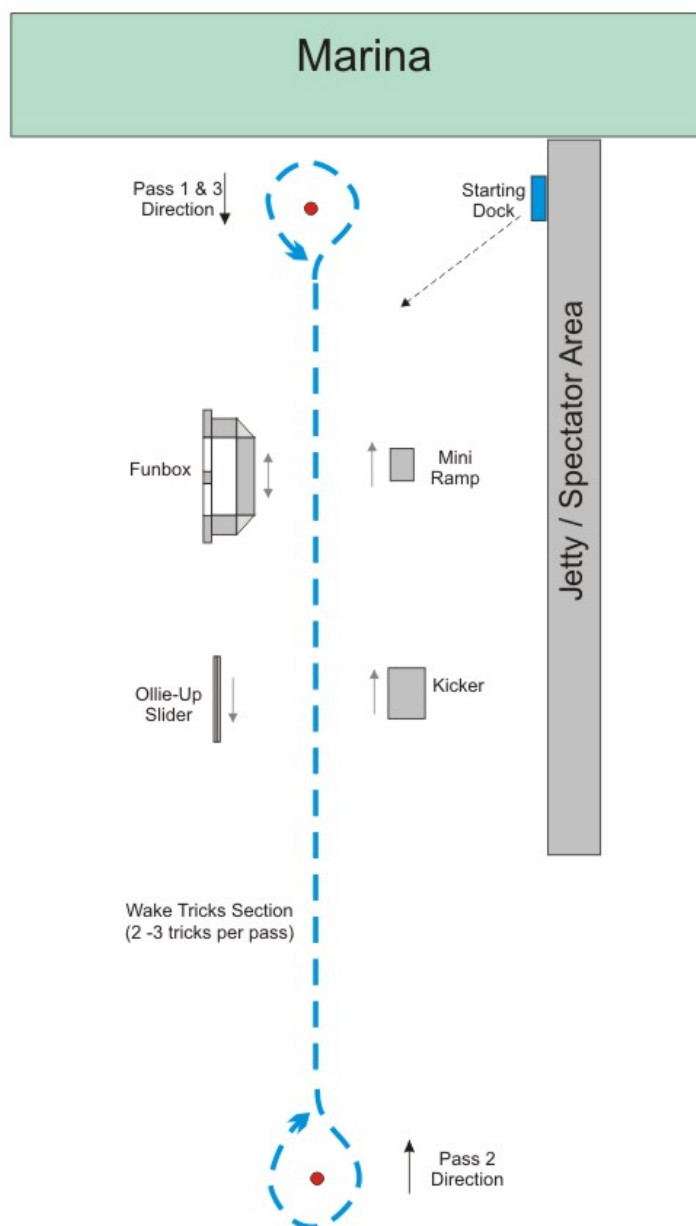
THE FORMAT:

Each competitor will have a total of 3 passes. The boat will pick up the rider from the starting dock and head straight into the course for riders to commence their first pass. Wakeboarders will be allowed 1 fall anytime during the course, and their run will end after their 2nd fall. Wakeskaters are allow one additional fall allowance. If a rider falls after the obstacle section on the 3rd pass, that would end the run even if he has fall allowances.

Riders will be judged based on Composition (40%), Obstacles (30%), Air Tricks (30%). There are no restrictions to the number of tricks performed, however, certain trick restrictions may apply for each category.

All riders must wear a life vest and helmet, even if they don't intend to hit any obstacles. Riders are also required to register on-site at least 1 hour before their scheduled event.

THE CATEGORIES:



Category Type	Restriction
Under 12 Wakeboard	No spins or inverts off the wake or obstacles. No restriction on surface spins (water or obstacle)
Freeride Womens Wakeboard	Maximum 2 spins or inverts off the wake or obstacles. No restriction on surface spins (water or obstacle).
Freeride Mens Wakeboard	Maximum 2 spins or inverts off the wake or obstacles. No restriction on surface spins (water or obstacle).
Freeride Wakeskate	No flips or shuvs more than 180
Open Womens Wakeboard	No trick restriction
Open Mens Wakeboard	No trick restriction
Open Wakeskate	No trick restriction

Note :

- Spins are defined as 360 degree rotation or more.
- Layout of obstacles may be subject to change.
